RUTH MILLER BRYSON November 11, 1912 - ?

Ruth Miller Bryson felt strongly about the relationship of peace to spirituality when she heard about the Friends Meeting of Washington in 1943. The Meeting, open to members from all over the country, received a letter from Ruth stating that she could not find a church in her town, Poland, Ohio, which spoke to her condition, or any Meeting. After reading Faith and Practice and the Book of Discipline, she applied for and was accepted into membership by the Meeting.

She moved to California in 1948 and lived in various locations there until her death, the exact date of which is not known. While living in Vallejo, California, she attended Berkeley Friends Church.

A recent communication from her daughter notified the Meeting of her death, but did not give the date.
